Among those who die with a reputation of holiness, the Holy Spirit promotes some as being models and intercessors of the People of God. In our days, too, as in the whole of history, the Church proclaims new saints and new Causes of canonisation are opened.

The Instruction Sanctorum Mater dated 17 May 2007, issued by the Congregation for the Causes of Saints, states that the beginning of all processes of canonisation is proof that there is "an authentic and widespread reputation of holiness" and of favours. In the case of Fr José María, there are many who appeal to his intercession before God. A large number of people go to pray to his tomb, which is located in the church of Montalegre, in Barcelona. We transcribe a letter which gives an idea of how extended this private devotion is:

"Dear friends in the Office for the Causes of Saints: We, Mining Engineers, are not a very large group in Spain. Amongst ourselves, when a fellow professional from any part of the country turns to another, he is always well attended to, even though he might not be known personally. Why is this confraternity going to disappear when we seek the help of a colleague who is now further away, enjoying the presence of God? I test this every now and again, when I ask Fr José María Hernández

Garnica for a favour. He always looks after what I ask him.

A friend of mine, who is not a believer, tells me his problems. Don't worry, I respond immediately, I am going to ask an engineer who is going to be a saint to help you. There were four problems: the health of his mother, who had just received an analysis in which they told her to go to the doctor immediately; his brother-in-law who had been left without a job; his house which he wished to sell because it had become too large and expensive to maintain, and he preferred to live in a smaller flat; and his job, because they had downgraded him and were going to pay him less after reorganising his work.

After praying the prayer card to Fr José María for a few weeks for those intentions, the solutions have arrived, one after another: with his mother, what has remained are the ailments natural at her age; his brother-in-law has found work; a person is now interested in buying his house; and he himself has now had two interviews which can result in a job with better working conditions.

I want to express my gratitude for these favours, and that Fr José María will not mind me continuing to ask for others, for the list of needs in my family and my friends is a long one."

A friend of mine had a serious infection in one leg, and he was very near to having it amputated. He was in hospital for two months and I went to see him often. His condition was unchanging and his wound did not heal. They gave him an artificial skin, but without any success for his body rejected it. The doctors could not find a solution. I gave him a prayer card of Fr José María so that he could pray for his cure. Nine days later, another surgeon, a specialist in circulation, saw clearly that they would have to operate, inserting a new vein to facilitate blood flow in the wound. After that operation he improved a lot, they let him leave with a skin graft and it worked well. We both attribute his cure to Fr José María, who after nine days of prayer made it possible for a more specialized surgeon to attend to him.

On my last trip, a virus got into my computer and it was driving me mad for a number of days.
